


How to export an image from iphoto on a Mac with the correct file size and name for a WWPC salon




Step one: File > Export






Step two: Resize your image.

In this dialog box you will want to make your settings read JPEG, High (quality), and set your Size to Custom and then set your max dimension to 1280 px. This way your image will come out to be the right size regardless whether it is a vertical or horizonal image. Once you have filled in all this information you may click the "export" button at the bottom of the dialog box.





Step three: Rename your file with the WWPC naming convention and direct your computer where to save the new file.

NAMING CONVENTION FOR ALL IMAGES:

- 1. Category: Creative, Nature, Realistic, or Print, followed by a space, then a hyphen and then a space;
- 2. Title, which should use capitalization and spaces between words, followed by a space, then a hyphen and then a space;
- 3. Photographer's three-digit ID number.
- 4. If the image is part of the special assignment salon topic, the Category part of the name would be the usual Category followed by a hyphen and then "Assignment".

It is very important that this protocol be followed. Images may be rejected if not named correctly. Examples:

Nature - Heron Waiting - 101

Realistic - On the Red River - 456

Creative - Shooting - 532

Realistic-Assignment - Beautiful Sunset - 365
