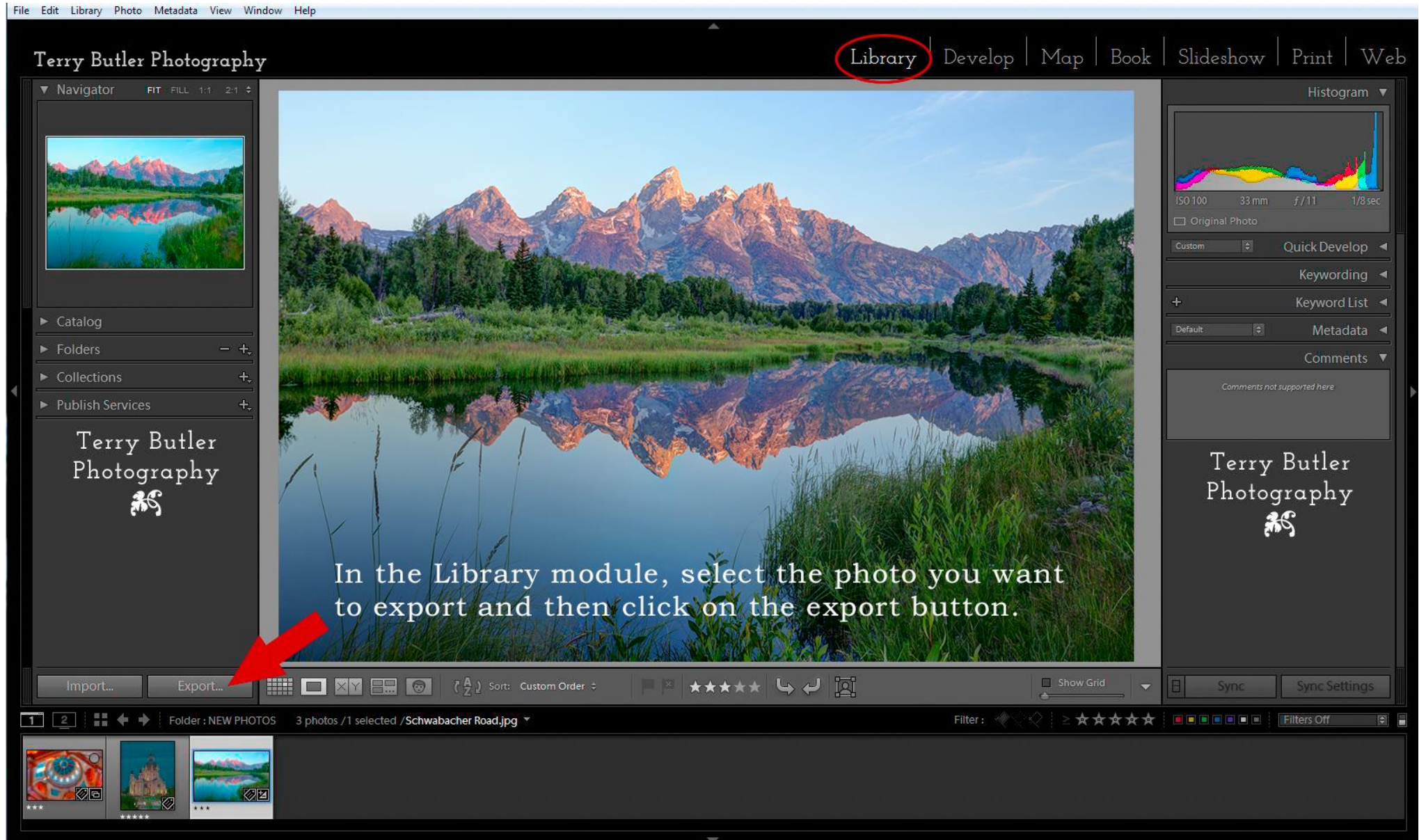


Resizing and Exporting an Image Using Lightroom

Exporting an image creates a copy of the image without damaging the original.



Export One File

Export To: **Hard Drive**

Export One File

1. Do not use the Export to Email option. Export to Hard Drive

2. Use the Specific folder option, click on Choose and navigate to where you want to save the file. I have a folder on my desktop named "Email today."

3. Enter a Custom Name that follows the file-naming conventions we use.

4. Use "JPEG" for the Image Format and "sRGB" for the Color Space.

5. For N4C contests only, the file size needs to be limited to 500 kilobytes or less

6. For Image Sizing click on the Resize to Fit box and then in the popup menu, choose long edge, and enter 1280 pixels. Also check the Don't Enlarge box.

7. When finished with step 1- 6 click the "Add" button below, to add a preset. In the dialog box give the preset a name and then click "Create"

8. When done, click the "Export" button.
